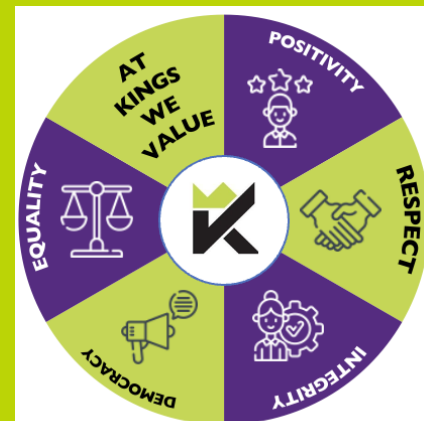


Revision Sessions – May Half-Term
