Dear Parent/Carer

Expressive Arts Trip to Barcelona – Friday 18 October to Monday 21 October 2024

The Expressive Arts Faculty is delighted to be able to offer 40 students across Years 9, 10 and 12 the opportunity to visit Barcelona from Friday 18 October to Monday 21 October 2024. Although the visit is not essential to your child's chosen course of study, it will allow students to encounter experiences that are unavailable in the classroom. The itinerary has been devised to provide young people the chance to experience cultures, respect differences, and thus broaden their horizons and knowledge.

Whilst in Barcelona, students studying an Art endorsement will create a sketchbook journal documenting their experience through drawing, collage, text and photography. The journal can be entered as part of the GCSE 60% controlled assessment and for Sixth Form as part of their 60% A Level personal investigation portfolio. On their return, students will have the opportunity to develop, refine and complete their travel journals ready for assessment.

Barcelona boasts more Art Nouveau buildings than any other city in the world. It is famed for its Art, Design, Architecture, Culture and Style. We will visit Antoni Gaudi's remarkable Sagrada Familia Cathedral, stroll the streets of Las Ramblas and Carrer Tallers and visit Boqueira Market. Also a visit to MACBA and Girona, Figures for the Dali Museum and Picasso Museum to immerse ourselves in Catalan Art and Pablo Picasso's and Dali's permanent collections. We will also visit the famous Parc Guell which contains amazing stone structures, mosaic tiling, more Gaudi Architecture and a breath taking view of the City. Finally, La Pedrera, Casa Mila roof top for a Night Experience and Flamenco Show at Cordobes.

The trip will leave on Friday 18 October 2024 from Bristol Airport (a time to be confirmed) and return on Monday 21 October 2024 (a returning time to be confirmed). The total cost of the educational visit will be £800 which will be payable in instalments.

Please ensure your child has a valid passport as we will require a copy prior to the trip.

Payment for this trip must be made using the online ParentPay system. If you are unable to pay online, you can pay by cash at a store showing the Paypoint logo. You will need a Paypoint letter which is available from the school office. The letter has a barcode which is unique to this trip. ParentPay and barcode letters are also used as acceptance of your parental consent and that you are satisfied with the arrangements outlined above. Reply slips for consent are no longer issued. A full medical form and Code of Conduct will be required prior to departure which will be issued nearer the time. Payments are non-refundable. Should your child withdraw from the trip, we are only able to offer a refund if their place can be filled by another student.

All that is required initially is the deposit of £250.00, which is non-refundable on gaining a place on the trip. **The trip will open on ParentPay at 8.30am on Wednesday 8 May 2024** and the deadline for the initial deposit is Monday 13 May 2024. If the trip is oversubscribed, places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

The remaining payments can be spread out between now and when the final payment must be paid to the Tour Operator.

The suggested payment schedule for the deposit and remaining balance is as follows:

If preferred, the full and final payment can be made immediately. Whether you chose to use the payment plan or not, it is essential all the above deadlines are met in order to secure a place on the trip.

The visit will be covered by the Academy Insurance Policy. Please be aware that:

- Except for visits abroad, insurance arrangements are the same as those for pupils in the Academy, i.e. only provides cover if negligence is proven or accepted by the Academy and/or its employees.
- You should consider making your own insurance arrangements for personal accident cover for your son/daughter for Academy activities.
- As parent/carer you have fully understood and are satisfied with the details supplied about the above-mentioned activities. You agree to your son/daughter taking part in it, and know of no medical reason why he/she should not participate.
